Those themes may include but are not limited to: Hiking, Mountain Biking, Camping, Bialthon, Forestry, Canoeing, Fishing, Naturalist, and Local Culture and History.

Responsibilities

- Set up curriculum, arrange guides, presenters and field trips with NREC Board.
- Provide a list of needed materials and equipment needed in advance.
- Organize and lead small group activities on each theme.
- Identify and respond to participant behavioral issues.
- Communicate with parents regarding participant's experiences and daily activities.
- Report concerns to NREC Board.
- Oversee and mentor intern and complete an evaluation of their work.
- Know and understand all safety guidelines and emergency procedures
